A total of 124 schools ...

The total of 124 schools ultimately entered the competition and though a few (less than 10) withdrew, it was necessary to run an extra round of the competition.

Regional Heats ...

These took place during the week of the 18th of October in the main and were a great success with the participants. At this level, the teachers from the schools also acted as judges and demonstrated a commitment to fairness.

Local Organisers ...

Without the help of local organisers, many of them carrying out this kind of task for the first time, the competition would not have been the success it was. They are now involved in organising the next stage, which is the Regional Finals (see Diary Dates box). The Competition ...

The three sections appeared to be very popular, though the tasks were far from easy. We were surprised to see the way the students tackled them with considerable ingenuity and gusto. Sometimes the performance was truly of epic proportions. Very well done to all the contestants

ESU Public Speaking Competition

In May 2005 the International Public Speaking Competition of the ESU with representatives from around 40 nations will take place in London. This year we hope to be able to send two participants to the competition.

Hungarian Competition ...

We will have Regional Heats, Regional Finals and a National Final, much in the same way as with the Chatangoljunk competition. This is different, however, as it is for students aged 16 to 20 years in full time education. Two years ago our winner was a 16 year old from Budapest. Last year the winner was a 19 year old from Nyiregyháza.

Qualifying ...

If you have students who wish to take part and qualify (as above) then be ready to apply when the request for applications comes and get your students ready. We hope to have lots of other prizes, too and hope that sponsors will come on board to make the competition bigger than last year when we had 70 applicants.
